Forests have been made fragile everywhere in the world. However, they form an efficient rampart against many current weather-related problems: lack of drinking water, arid soil, global warming, the accelerated disappearance of animals and plants etc.

The following figures testify to the threats weighing on them: every year, 13 million hectares of forests disappear. This represents a surface equivalent to a football field every three seconds! This pace is alarming for it will take several centuries for the forest to grow again...

Why should we preserve our trees? Because the forests in which they grow are essential for our planet.

- Conserve fresh water: Forests play a fundamental role in regulating the fresh-water cycle as well as maintaining water quality. Via their root systems, trees retain rainwater and replenish water tables.
- **Fix and maintain soil**: The root systems of forests provide a rampart against landslides, erosion and flooding.
- Combat global warming: Every day, trees absorb CO2 and convert it into energy in order to grow. Through this phenomenon, forests regulate the greenhouse gases which, when presents in the atmosphere in excessive quantities, are responsible for climate change.
- Account for 75% of living species: Forests are incredibly rich in terms of biodiversity, i.e. the variety of animal and plant species within a given ecosystem. Forests thus constitute a key environmental asset as hosts of generic diversity, essential to life on earth.
- Are essential for health: Plants allow man to create new drugs. Approximately 75% of commercial therapeutic drugs have a natural origin. For example, the aspirin is a derivative of acetylsalicylic acid, found naturally in willow bark.
- **Directly support the livelihood of 1.6 billion people**: For one-fifth of mankind, forests represent an irreplaceable source of food, fuel, water, building material, medicinal plants, etc.


